1. Apologies

2. Removal of climbing frame – following consultation with user groups it was AGREED to cover the dangerous bolts and leave in situ.
3. Millside Gateway. The gap adjacent to the gates has been filled so out of hours the park cannot be accessed.
4. U/8 gates. This remains outstanding. Cllr Hanton to investigate solutions - next meeting.
5. Recreation benches (memorial). It was AGREED to defer this project.
6. Skate park repairs. Current quotations are in the region of £1760 for board to enable the critical repairs to be undertaken. Total price to main Council meeting. Cllr Gelinas.
7. Antisocial behaviour. SNAP representative to raise at the next meeting. Cllr Baverstock.
8. Grass cutting Millside been done – the rubbish bins remain unemptied. Rotor spinner has been removed. The site of removal will be backfilled with topsoil. Cllr Hanton.
9. It AGREED to recommend to Council that GP and leisure combine meeting to lessen the number of meetings.
